



Obstacle Sports Event Licence Requirements

Agreement Version 1.0

License requirements may be updated periodically. Previous licensing does not guarantee future licensing. Please ensure you gain licensing approval before using UKOSF license information on your website or social channels. A licence application may not be accepted by UKOSF, due to previous actions of an event organiser which are deemed unacceptable, or where UKOSF has concerns of any nature regarding the grant of the licence.

Requirements:

UKOSF may request evidence of some or all of the below as part of granting a licence.

1. Meet the UKOSF definition of an obstacle race.
2. All competitive events or race waves have documented rules available to athletes prior to the event.
3. All competitive events or race waves to be officiated or have clear guidance if officiated via alternative methods.
4. For competitive events or race waves publish verified online results.
5. Appropriate insurance is in place for the activity and size of the event.
6. Mandatory risk assessments completed with evidence that the required control measures are in place.
7. First aid or medical provision in place which meets the required obligations for the size and capacity of the event.
8. Safeguarding practices in place and evidenced for all athletes, volunteers and spectators.
9. Clearly documented refund policy available to participants (Note this does not mean you have to give a refund unless required by law).
10. Show a good track record of event management based on feedback from previous licenced events.
11. Follow safety guidelines and restrictions with regards to Covid-19.
12. Display UKOSF logo with 'License applied for' or 'License number: XXXXX'

Failure by an event organiser to comply with these standards may result in the refusal of future licence applications. Should UKOSF refuse to accept a licence whether due to previous actions of the event organiser, UKOSF shall be under no obligation to provide written reasons for refusal.

Sanctions

UKOSF is serious in its commitment to high standards of behaviour. Events who bring the sport into disrepute will be subject to sanctions as follows:

Issues may be dealt with informally or formally and may result in the imposition of sanctions commensurate to the seriousness of the misconduct (taking into account any history of misconduct). Those sanctions may include:

1. An informal warning or final warning.
2. Immediate licence withdrawal
3. Future licence withdrawal
