Overview

This Selection Policy (“the Policy”) outlines the process by which British Obstacle Sports will determine its selection for the British National Team (“BNT”) for 2023 international federated events (“the Championships”). In all cases, selection will be conditional on athletes meeting the eligibility criteria outlined and signing the Team Members Agreement (“TMA”).

The BNT will be selected based on the following criteria (listed in priority order):

1. The achievement of qualifying criteria when applicable
2. To maximise medals at the Championship
3. To maximise top 10 elite placings at the Championships
4. To ensure representation within age groups with limited planned athlete participation at the Championships
5. To give all athletes a fair opportunity to demonstrate their form prior to full team selection while also enabling selected athletes the time to book the required travel
6. To select individual athletes demonstrating future elite medal potential
7. To maximise top 10 age group placings at the Championships.

British Obstacle Sports will sanction BNT selection events in 2023, where athletes can achieve automatic selection for certain international events and distances. National Trials may include athletes who are not eligible to represent British Obstacle Sports. These athletes are excluded from the National Trials results for the purposes of selection.

In addition, the British Obstacle Sports Selection Committee will determine the complete BNT as detailed in this document. The Selection Committee is a sub-committee of the OCR and Ninja Sport Technical Committees and is chaired by Fabian Yeo.

We recommend attendance at British National Trials if you would like to be selected where appropriate, but the BOS Selection Committee reserves the right to use other data to make selection decisions.

British National Team Application Form

If you would like to represent Team UK at the 2023 [OCR European Championships](#) or [FISO OCR World Championships](#) you must complete an BNT application by the listed deadlines. This is required for all athletes even if you have already qualified or been selected.

General National Trials Rules

1. Only those eligible for selection are included in the results for the purposes of selection (e.g. if the first athlete in the 15K National Trial is from France then their result is not counted for selection purposes).
 2. There will be no roll down of automatic qualification slots at selection events. In the event the automatically selected athlete does not wish to take up their position at the Championship or has already been selected, then the Selection Committee will select another, based on athlete performances, recent race history and previous major competition history (see Selection Process for more info).
 3. Athletes must finish the race to be selected automatically regardless of the number of finishers in the competition.
 4. There is no 50% rule for National Trials selection.
 5. If fewer athletes compete in a National Trials competitive category than there are automatic selections available then these are selected by the BOS Selection Committee instead. For example, if only two athletes in the F50-54 complete the 15K National Trial then they are both selected automatically and the third automatic spot is selected by the BOS Selection Committee.
 6. British Obstacle Sports reserves the right to extend the automatic selection deadline for athletes to accept a place at its sole discretion.

The selection committee will endeavour to ensure:

- An even split of male and female athletes.
- The representation of one Masters athlete in each gender.
- The representation of one Junior athlete (U20) in each gender.

However, the selection committee reserves the right to override this in the pursuit of the listed BNT objectives.

National Relay Team

Any qualified athletes may compete in the competitive team relay and represent British Obstacle Sports. British Obstacle Sports may help to organise teams, but this is not required to compete.

100m

There are 18 places available (9 male, 9 female) in the 100m FISO OCR World Championship British National Team. These will be selected via National Trials and a selection process.

Note that Spartan Race 3K is an invite only event. British Obstacle Sports will have a limited number of invitations that can be given to British athletes. Those athletes wishing to be selected at this event should specify via the athlete application by January 20th. If we receive more requests than available spots for the Elite 3K National Trial then the BOS Selection Committee will decide who should be invited. The selection committee also reserves the right to not invite an athlete who does not demonstrate the form to be selected to the 3K Elite National Team regardless of how many athletes apply.

3K Elite National Team (5 male, 5 female):

1. Spartan Race 3K selection event (April 2023) 1st place
2. Spartan Race 3K selection event (April 2023) 2nd place
3. Spartan Race 3K selection event (April 2023) 3rd place
4. Selected by BOS Selection Committee

* Athletes must make the Spartan Race 3K final (top 15) to have the opportunity to be automatically selected for the Elite British National Team. The BOS Selection Committee will make any applicable selections two or less British athletes make the final.

Para

Adaptive athletes are invited to compete by British Obstacle Sports. There will be a selection process for the 100m and National Team Race where more than one Para athlete applies for a place on the team.

National Team Race

A squad of up to 18 athletes will be selected for the National Relay Team to compete in the following categories:

1. Mixed National Team Race (One female, two male athletes)*
2. Female National Relay Team
3. Male National Relay Team
4. Para National Relay Team (Three team members, with at least one Para athlete)

The BOS Selection Committee will prioritise selection for the Mixed National Team Race as this is the only team race that includes prize money and is considered the 'Elite' team race.

Selection Process

Eligibility

1. To be considered for selection, athletes must:
 - a. Complete an adult or junior online application by the required deadline
 - b. Be a British Obstacle Sports member.
 - c. Not have represented another federation in the previous 12 months prior to the Championships.
 - d. Obtain a medical certificate (OCR European Championships only)
 - e. Complete the WADA Anti-Doping e-Learning (ADeL) course (FISO OCR World Championships only)
 - f. Medical Diagnostic Form for Athletes with Physical Impairment (Para Athletes only)
 - g. Sign the TMA and abide by its terms and conditions.
2. Once selected athletes must:
 - a. Register for the selected events at their own cost
 - b. Organise appropriate travel and insurance arrangements for the selected event at their own cost
 - c. Continue to abide by the terms & conditions of the TMA

Selection announcements and process

1. Selection announcements will be made as soon as possible after the specified selection dates.
2. If there is availability in a competitive category the British Obstacle Sports Selection Committee may select an athlete on a case by case basis after the final selection dates.
3. The BOS Selection Committee may select National Team Race specialists who have not been selected in individual OCR disciplines.
4. Each selection announcement will be published on britishobstacle.org. Shortlisted athletes will be contacted prior to the announcement to confirm that they meet the eligibility criteria and their acceptance of the TMA.
5. The British Obstacle Sports Committee shall comprise as follows:
 - a. No more than 10 individuals
 - b. No one who plans to be selected for the British National Team excluding a National Team Captain and Vice-Captain selected by the committee
 - c. Ninja sport representation
 - d. Representation from each of the Home Nations*
 - e. Media representation*
 - f. Coaching representation*
 - g. Para representation*
 - h. Members independent of other British Obstacle Sports activities*

* As the panel is voluntary, bullets d-h. cannot be guaranteed.

6. Conflicts of interest must be declared in advance by the BOS Selection Committee. Individual committee members can not vote on a decision where they have a conflict. For example, if they coach an athlete in the male 40-44 age group, they can not vote in that competitive category.
7. Decisions are made by majority vote, with the Chairperson holding a casting vote in the event of a tie.
8. The quorum is 7 for a decision to be made. A committee member unable to vote due to a conflict of interest is considered as part of quorum calculation. They automatically abstain from voting when they have a conflict.
9. Athletes may be selected by the BOS Selection Committee prior to the selection dates with the approval of the Board noting the conflict of interest policy that applies.
10. The BOS Selection Committee will determine selections through athlete performances, recent race history and previous major competition history. The following data points will be considered at a minimum.
 - a. 2023 National Trial results
 - b. 2022 British Ninja Championships
 - c. 2022/2023 British Obstacle Sports Time Trials
 - d. 2022/23 UKOCR Series race results
 - e. 2023 Scottish OCR Series race results
 - f. 2022/23 UK Spartan race results
 - g. 2022 British OCR Junior Championship race results
 - h. 2022/23 OCR European Championship race results
 - i. 2022/23 Spartan European Championship race results
 - j. 2022 Spartan World Championship race results
 - k. 2022 Adventurey OCR World Championships race results
 - l. Athlete applications
11. In a circumstance where the BOS Selection Committee can not make a final decision, the British Obstacle Technical Committees (excluding any competing Team UK athletes) will arbitrate until a decision is made.
12. Selections will be subject to the maximum quota for each competitive category as permitted by the Championship and as specified in this document.
13. Reserves
 1. The Panel may select up to two additional reserves for any event.

General Provisions

De-selection and replacements

1. Athletes may be de-selected due to:
 - a. Illness or injury
 - b. Failure to comply with the terms and conditions of the TMA
 - c. For any reason approved by the British Obstacle Sports Board
2. In such circumstances replacements will be selected (in order of execution):
 - a. Via the selection of a reserve
 - b. Via an ad hoc panel selection specific to gap created by the deselection

Appeals

1. Athletes may appeal their non-selection and/or deselection (as applicable), but only after the relevant final selection date. This can be done via <https://britishobstacle.org/contact-us/>
